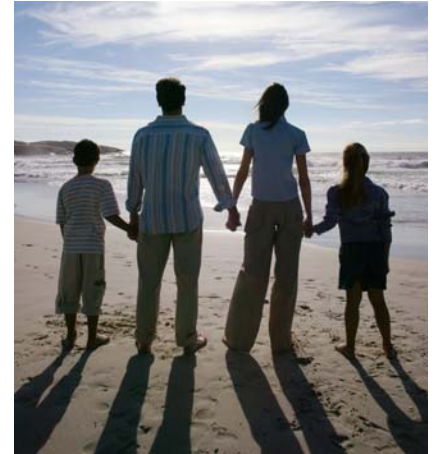

The Master's Morning Schedule January 10-March 14, 2010

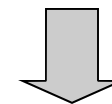
